Arborist Letter to Village of Dobbs Ferry,

My name is Richard M. Ovalle, certified ISA arborist (ID: NY-6059A), and I am writing on behalf of my client, Tigre Tree Service, where the tree in question is at 49 Cricket Lane, to state my recommendations for tree removal.

Silver Maple

The tree I am writing about is an Acer saccharinum commonly known as Silver Maple gets its name from the silvery undersides of its leaves. This is one of the largest deciduous native trees, typically growing to 50-80' (less frequently to 100') tall with a rounded open spreading crown. It is native to eastern and central North America where it typically occurs in moist to wet, sometimes mucky, often poorly drained soils on floodplains, along the edges of streams and rivers and in low woods. It is a fast-growing, somewhat graceful tree that formerly was a very popular urban landscape selection for lawns and streets, but has more recently fallen somewhat out of favor because of the proclivity of its weak-wooded limbs to split when stressed by high winds or ice/snow.

This tree, with a DBH of 42", is growing in boggy conditions along a pond's edge. The tree had a codominant stem peel off during the coastal storm last Tuesday, December 26th, most likely due to high winds. The homeowners called, stating this was an emergency when they heard the loud crash of branches breaking. The fact that much of the codominant stem was already dead, and by the looks of it, for a long time which made easy work for the wind. The codominant stem had its own codominant stem which added to the weight of the stem. Codominant stems are two or more main stems that emerge from the same location on the main trunk. Though such stems may look fine to the casual observer, they may actually be dangerous. The codominant stems form a "V" union which is more likely to fail than a "U" Union. Stems with a "V' union compress bark between them as they grow, leaving little physical connection. The tree is a Hazard and that is why the homeowner called Tigre Tree Service to remove the tree and prevent further liability. Basically, half the tree fell in one swoop, so its only logical to remove the whole thing.

This Silver Maple had a good life but the Decay had already set in and was spreading throughout the vascular system unchecked. Not only was there Decay, but signs of borers who attack the tree's vascular system. I could not tell if there were any girdling roots since the area was totally saturated and walking up close was not advisable. It's a wonder how the tree survived all those years in such low oxygen soil. Girdling roots strangle the tree, like pinching an artery, so this my have led to the death of some branches. Sounds like three strikes to me. The tree was not in good health, not worth saving and a Hazard. Removal will reduce liability.
