


Please be advised, the Board at Beacon Hill Estates approved Almstead Tre & Shrub Care Company to remove five trees on the premises.

#### **Arbor Care Recommendations**

The following recommendations are for Arbor Care on the property, which includes all phases of pruning, cabling, and tree removals. Unless otherwise noted: branches are chipped and removed from the property, and stumps are cut as close to grade as conditions will allow; and when stump grinding is recommended, stumps are ground 6-8" below grade and the hole is backfilled with the resulting debris.

#### Arbor Care: Tree Pruning & Removals

#### Location: Pool & Garden Area

- Take down one (1) 22" Norway Maple located outside of fence area growing over garden (tree is marked with a ribbon).
- 2. Prune to reduce lateral branches on the Norway Maple located outside fence area to help allow more light to garden area, prune to reduce 4" branch (split) over sitting bench area and prune to clean crown of dead branches approximately 1" in diameter or larger.
- Prune to reduce one (1) 16" Norway Maple located at the rear of the fence on the hillside, two (2) limbs 5" & 7" encroaching over fence of garden area for clearance.

Observation: The large Red Oak to the left of lower gate (no trespassing sign) entry is 1/2 dead. You should check to see whos property this tree is on as it is a potential hazard.

All brush to be chipped and debris removed.




#### **Arbor Care Recommendations**

The following recommendations are for Arbor Care on the property, which includes all phases of pruning, cabling, and tree removals. Unless otherwise noted: branches are chipped and removed from the property, and stumps are cut as close to grade as conditions will allow; and when stump grinding is recommended, stumps are ground 6-8" below grade and the hole is backfilled with the resulting debris.

## Arbor Care: Tree Removals, Tree Pruning & Stump Grinding Location: Building C


- 1. Take down two (2) 8" Blue Spruce each ref Building C 93-97 by playground due to visible areas of limited live growth, previous Spruce at this location fell from storm damage. All brush to be chipped and remove debris.
- Grind stump of three (3) stump from Blue Spruce approximately 6-8" below grade backfill debris.



 **Arbor Care: Observation** - Large 38" Red Oak located in the outside pool area (left of lower gate entrance)

Tree is in decline approximately ½ of the crown is dead, removal is recommended to remove risk. Is this tree on Beacon Hill property – will need to review before plan for removal before providing a cost.

Note: this tree is on the neighboring property on the rear left side of Building A 104 (carriage house). Black walnut tree should be removed to remove risk of failure and damage to Beacon Hill property.





#### Location: Ashford Avenue - Ref Building A 104

- Prune to reduce and raise lower crown limbs on one (1) large 36" Norway Maple located over wall and sidewall for clearance and prune to clean crown of dead limbs 2" in diameter or larger.
- 2. Take down two (2) 16" & 17" Norway Maple located in the front right due to past storm damage of crowns. All brush to be chipped and remove debris.

Note: Equipment will park on Ashford Avenue and block sidewalk







- 3. Take down one (1) 34" Ash due to visible decline ref building K shed, parking area stairs, cars must be clear of area for removal.
- 4. Take down one (1) 22" Red Maple due to crown decline approximately 50% lawn area border.





- 5. Grind stump of one (1) Ash approximately 6-8" below grade backfill debris.
- 6. Grind stump of one (1) Red Maple approximately 6-8" below grade backfill debris.

#### **Arbor Care Definitions**

Pruning Standards: Experts in the field of arboriculture have established a committee to develop standards of tree maintenance. This committee, working with the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), developed standards from pruning and other aspects of tree care. These standards provide for a higher, more uniform level of service and help ensure public safety.

Almstead adheres to the principals of the International Society of Arboriculture (ISA), the Tree Care Industry Association (TCIA) and The American National Standard for Tree Care Operations – Tree, Shrub and other Woody Plant Maintenance – Standard Practices (ANSI A300). All work shall be completed in compliance with A300 Standards.

#### **Pruning Objectives:**

Structural Pruning: Structural pruning shall consist of selective pruning to improve tree and branch architecture primarily on young- and medium-aged trees.

Restoration Pruning: Restoration shall consist of selective pruning to redevelop structure, form, and appearance of severely pruned, vandalized, or damaged trees.

Vista Pruning: Vista/view pruning shall consist of the use of one or more pruning methods (types) to enhance a specific line of sight.

#### **Pruning Methods:**

Prune to Clean: Cleaning shall consist of pruning to remove one or more of the following non-beneficial parts: dead, diseased, and/or broken branches.

Prune to Thin: Thinning shall consist of selective pruning to reduce density of live branches.

Prune to Raise: Raising shall consist of pruning to provide vertical clearance.


Prune to Reduce: Reducing shall consist of pruning to decrease height and/or spread.

Take Down: Removing a tree and cutting stump as flush to grade as possible.

Stump Grinding: Grinding the stump to recommended depth below grade and backfilling with the resulting debris/wood chips.

Cabling: Cables restrict the distance that branches can move in relation to each other. Installed across a weak junction, they will greatly reduce the risk of failure. Installed on overextended branches, they can be used to support the branch.

**Bracing:** Brace rods are used to reduce the risk of two or more stems spreading farther apart or moving sideways in relation to each other. They are also used to fasten together a junction or branch that is split apart.
