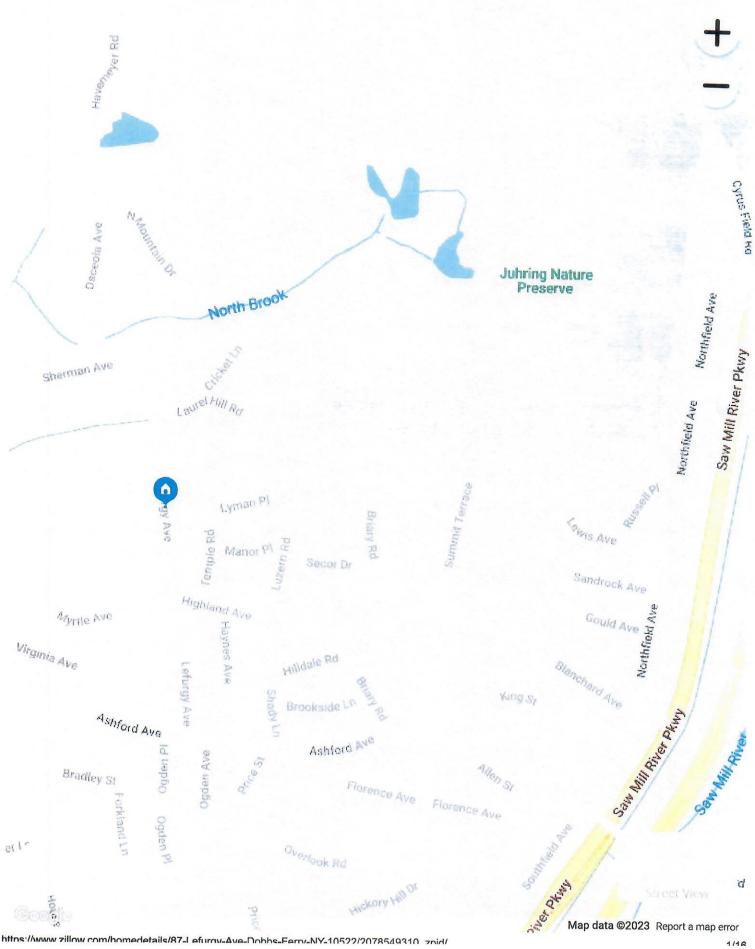

Pursuant to a review of the submitted proposed plans to construct a new House, the following determinations were made.

The property is located in the OF-2 Zone. Requiring one variance.

1. The required combined (both) side yard setback is 50 feet, you are proposing a combined (both) side yard setback 43.9 feet thus requiring a variance for 6.1 feet.

For these reasons your proposal, as submitted, is denied pending zoning board review.
