Re: Garbage & Recycling Bins Proposal

In June 2023, the Village received a proposal from the Downtown Committee, Beautification Committee and the Sustainability Committee regarding adding new garbage and recycle bins throughout the Village. The original proposal was to add 25 sets of garbage and recycling bins for a grand total of approximately \$62,000.00.

Part of the issue is that most of the garbage and recycle bins do not match throughout the Village and we totally agree that this is not the aesthetic the DPW is going for. We would like to remove the brown and black damaged and rusted garbage bins throughout the Village and replace them with new receptacles that match the existing black/blue receptacles to achieve more of a uniform look.

We agree with replacing the receptacles in the downtown but we would like to discuss some additional options. We would like to ask Springhurst to put in a garbage/recycle bin at the bottom of the staircase of Beacon Hill and ask the school to maintain the collection of the refuse. We are also going to request that the Old Croton Aqueduct put the garbage and recycling bins at the intersections of Walnut, Chestnut, Elm and Oak. These locations are not Village property and we feel that the school and OCA should be involved in keeping refuse on school property and state property.

Some additional locations that the DPW is considering are locations along Ashford Avenue including:

- Walgrove & Ashford
- Bellewood & Ashford
- Storm & Ashford
- Beacon Hill & Ashford

- Washington & Ashford
- Ogden Avenue & Ashford
- Irvington & Ashford

We are asking the Board to consider breaking the proposal into two or three phases.

- Phase One: Downtown Bins
  - Replace 12 sets of bins along Main and Cedar Street including 4 locations along Main Street and 8 locations along Cedar Street
  - Grand Total of approximately \$30,000.00
- Phase Two: Ashford Bins
  - Add 7 sets of garbage/recycling bins along Ashford Avenue between Walgrove Avenue and Irvington Street
  - o Grand Total of approximately \$18,000.00
- Phase Three: Parks Bins
  - Add 5 additional sets of garbage/recycle bins to Waterfront Park
  - Add 3 additional sets of garbage/recycle bins to Gould Park
  - o Grand Total of approximately \$20,000.00

We are approaching the time of the year when we start putting together our budget to be presented to the Board and we are asking the Board to consider the above proposal to be budgeted for in the upcoming 2024-25 budget.
