Open Meetings Law was recently amended adding §103-a providing an additional option for board members to participate using video-conferencing. This new section does not supplant the existing section which, as you know, permits board members to participate remotely by video only if the public is provided with notice of and accessibility to that member's location.

The new provision §103-a expands the ability to meet using remote access video technology without the added public notice and accessibility requirements, but only under "extraordinary circumstances". Unfortunately, the term is not defined, instead §103-a lists the examples "disability, illness, caregiving responsibilities, or any other significant or unexpected factor or event which precludes the member's physical attendance at such meeting."

The Village has discretion whether to authorize the option in §103-a. But in order to benefit from the expanded remote opportunity, the Village Board must adopt a local law authorizing use of videoconferencing and establishing procedures for its use. The law may also authorize the option for the Village's other boards and committees which are subject to Open Meetings Law.

Based on your guidance, I am prepared to draft a local law regarding §103-a and assist the staff with appropriate language for legal notices and agendas going forward. On Friday, I attended an informational session with the Director of the Committee on Open Government and was able to pose questions and get some answers on your behalf, including confirmation of some specific language as acceptable for both a law and notices. It was clearly stated that the Village need not create a comprehensive list of qualifying "circumstances" and could provide a more broad overview instead.

The Committee on Open Government is conducting another informational session with Q&A on May 19 at 10:00 am. I am attaching the flyer for this event should you or staff be interested in participating.
