RESOLUTION -2024

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DOBBS FERRY REMOVING ON-STREET LOADING ZONES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE

WHEREAS, on November 24, 2020 the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry adopted Local Law #7-2020 which established a uniform process for this Board to designate onstreet parking spaces on Village Streets for use as loading zones upon recommendation by the Chief of Police for the purpose of protecting the public, easing traffic flow of traffic and in support of local commercial businesses; and

WHEREAS, at a public meeting on November 14, 2023, the Administrator, on behalf of the Chief of Police, presented evidence to this Board and made recommendation for the relocation of a certain loading zone space to a new location that meets the criteria under the law, and the Board has determined this location as appropriate for designation as loading zones; and

WHEREAS, on November 28, 2023 at the regular Board Meeting of the Village of Dobbs Ferry, by Resolution 218-2023, the Board of Trustees designated the following on-street location as a loading zone in accordance with Section 290-21 of Chapter 290 "Vehicles and Traffic" of the Village of Dobbs Ferry Code at a location starting 117 feet from the intersection of Cedar Street and Main Street on the south side of Cedar Street; and

WHEREAS, with the designation of the loading zone as set forth in Resolution 218-2023, the former loading zone located in front of 1 Cedar Street is no longer needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry hereby discontinues and eliminates the loading zone in front of 1 Cedar Street established by Resolution 51-2020 and converts the former loading zone back into two full time public parking spaces subject to the parking enforcement provisions in Chapter 290 of the Village of Dobbs Ferry Code.
