old one as surplus equipment.

Date: March 30, 2022

In the 2022-2023 fiscal budget, the Fire Department requested to purchase a new Fire Chiefs vehicle to replace our current 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe. This current vehicle needs approximately \$8,000 dollars' worth of work and is out of warranty. Generally we like to keep these vehicles on a 6 to 7 year cycle. By us following this cycle, we optimize the resale value of the vehicle we are trying to sell, and we do not incur the costs of what it would be to repair them.

During the budget process while working with the Village Administrator, and Village Treasurer, it was determined that we have the funds in the Fire Departments current 2021-2022 operating budget, along with the approximate resale value of the current Chiefs vehicle which is about \$30,000 to cover the cost of a new Chiefs vehicle.

At this time, I am requesting that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Fire Department to purchase a new 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe from DeNooyer Chevrolet off of NY State contract, for the amount of \$64,273.50, using the funds in the current 2021-2022 Fire Department operating budget, along with the funds we would be receiving in return from the sale of the current Chiefs vehicle.. I am also requesting that the Board of Trustees declares the current 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe as surplus equipment contingent upon the delivery of the new vehicle.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DOBBS FERRY FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE A NEW FIRE CHIEFS VEHICLE, AND DECLARE THE OLD CHEIFS VEHICLE AS SURPLUS EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Dobbs Ferry Fire Department currently maintains a 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe for the purposes of the Fire Chiefs getting to emergency calls quickly; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe is in need of \$8,000 in repairs and is outside of its warranty; and

WHEREAS, the Dobbs Ferry Fire Department requests that the 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe be declared as surplus equipment and utilize Signal 5 Fire apparatus LLC to broker the sale of this vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Dobbs Ferry Fire Department, is requesting to replace our current 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe with a 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe; and

WHEREAS, the Dobbs Ferry Fire Department has the funds available in the current 2021-2022 operating budget to cover the cost of the new vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the sale of the designated surplus equipment, the 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe, will offset the cost of the new vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Village of Dobbs Ferry Board of Trustees designates the 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe for the Dobbs Ferry Fire Department as surplus equipment, to be sold to help offset the purchase price of replacing the surplus equipment; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Dobbs Ferry Fire Department is authorized to purchase a 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe from DeNooyer Chevrolet off on NY State contract for the amount of \$64,273.50.
