#### RESOLUTION -2022

### RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING FEE COLLECTIONS FOR THE PARKING OF PASSENGER VEHICLES IN DESIGNATED AREAS

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees is continuing the review of options to better address the needs of the Village, residents, local businesses and the visiting public in connection with the use of on-street and off-street parking within the Village's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, as a means to provide additional time to consider opportunities following receipt of the traffic analysis prepared by Laybel Consulting, LLC, the Village Board has determined it will serve the public's best interest to extend the temporary waiver of enforcement of parking fees in specific areas of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that, with the explicit reservation of the right to enforce the two-hour time limit and all other provisions of law and regulations, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry hereby extends the temporary suspension of enforcement of parking fees from September 13, 2022 to October 31, 2022 for the benefit of its residents, local businesses and the visiting public, in the following designated areas of the downtown business district:

- (a) The on-street spaces controlled by parking meters on Main Street and Cedar Street; and
- (b) The non-restricted parking spaces in the off-street Municipal lots (i) behind Village Hall, (ii) at 99 Cedar Street and (iii) between Cedar and Oak Streets.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that, the suspensions set forth herein shall remain in effect for the stated duration, unless this Board takes further action to repeal, extend or modify said suspensions.
