Re: July 4th Fireworks Display

The Village of Dobbs Ferry Recreation Department is looking to once again host our annual 4th of July Fireworks display on Monday, July 4, 2022. We have reached out to three different companies, one was already booked, one wanted us to tell them how much we wanted to pay, but was unable to tell us what we would get for our money, and the third is the company we have used for several years. It is my recommendation that the Village enter into an agreement with Legion Fireworks to provide the 4th of July fireworks display for a cost not to exceed \$18,000. Should the weather not cooperate and the fireworks display is canceled on July 4th, the Village will pick an alternate date to be determined by the Board.

RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF DOBBS FERRY BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH LEGION FIREWORKS FOR JULY 4, 2022

WHEREAS, the Village of Dobbs Ferry Recreation Department is looking to once again host our annual fireworks display on Monday, July 4, 2022; and

WHEREAS, as is customary on July 4th, the Village is seeking to have a fireworks display for the benefit of the community; and

WHEREAS, after contacting three different firework companies, Legion Fireworks, the company who has provided the fireworks display in the Village for many years, has offered to provide the fireworks display for the Village event at an amount not to exceed \$18,000; and

WHEREAS, if the weather fails to cooperate and the fireworks are unable to be displayed on July 4th, the Village Board will pick an alternate date that will be determined at a later date; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Dobbs Ferry has funding for the annual July 4th fireworks display in the Celebrations line of the Village budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry hereby authorize the Village Administrator to execute and sign an agreement with Legion Fireworks to provide fireworks for the Village's 4th of July celebration for an amount not to exceed \$18,000; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement shall be subject to the review and approval of the Village attorney and the Village Administrator; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Village Administrator is authorized to take any and all necessary steps to effectuate the intent of this Resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
