## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF CFA GRANT APPLICATION FOR HIGH STREET PARK UPGRADES

WHEREAS, in order to revitalize an existing park resource which has fallen into disuse and encourage the public to take advantage of this dedicated open space, the Village of Dobbs Ferry is looking to upgrade the High Street Park ("Project") and is seeking funding under the "Environmental Protection Fund Grants Program for Parks, Preservation, and Heritage"; and WHEREAS, the cost estimate for the Project, which for purposes of the grant application will be entitled "High Street Park Upgrades", is \$ ; and WHEREAS, in connection with the Project, Village has prepared a Coastal Assessment Form as a prerequisite to determining consistency with the Local Waterfront Revitalization Program and an Environmental Assessment Form to commence the environmental review in compliance with the NY State Environmental Quality Review Act. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that following review of the Coastal Assessment Form and in accordance with the Waterfront Revitalization of Coastal Areas and Inland Waterways Act (Executive Law, Article 42) and its implementing regulations, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry hereby determines that the proposed Project is consistent with the Local Waterfront Revitalization Program; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that following review of the Environmental Assessment Form, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry hereby determines the proposed Project, classified as a Type II action in 6 CRR-NY 617.5 (C)(9), will result in no significant environmental impacts and will require no further environmental review in accordance with the NY State Environmental Quality Review Act (Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8) and its implementing regulations; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry hereby authorizes the Interim Village Administrator to take all necessary action to submit an application in Environmental Protection Fund Grants Program for Parks, Preservation, and Heritage funds for financing the "High Street Park Upgrades" project, and, upon the funding
