WHEREAS, The Dobbs Ferry Fire Department is requesting emergency repairs be made to the tower ladder; and

WHEREAS, It has been determined that these repairs need to be made in order for the tower ladder to function.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry herby authorizes Firematic Supply Company to make emergency repairs to the tower ladder not to exceed \$15,000

Date: May 3, 2023

While returning from a fire call, one of our drivers noticed a loud banging noise coming from the engine area of the tower ladder. After the truck was parked they also noticed an antifreeze fluid leak on the ground underneath the truck.

The truck was brought to Firematic Supply, the company who we purchased the truck from so it could be evaluated. After the truck was checked it was determined that one of the fan blades that keeps the engine cool broke off and put a hole in the radiator along with cutting some of the hoses that carry antifreeze, which are part of the system that keeps the engine cool.

This repair is essential and the truck cannot be used until it is complete.

The estimated cost of the repair is \$12,000 to \$15,000. We do have funds available in the current fiscal year budget to cover this unforeseen expense. I am asking permission to have Firematic Supply Company make the necessary emergency repair. Please feel free to contact me with any questions. Thank you.
