INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW

REVISION TO CHAPTER 238 OF THE DOBBS FERRY CODE RELATED TO ORGANIZED SIDEWALK SALES EVENTS

A LOCAL LAW to amend Dobbs Ferry Code Chapter 238 "Peddling" to clarify the role and responsibility of an organizer or sponsor to obtain an event-wide permit or license.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dobbs Ferry, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent. To clarify provisions related to peddling permits to make clear that an individual permit shall not be required of each participant in sponsored sidewalk sales and that the sponsor shall be responsible to obtain the necessary approvals and permits for the event.

Section 2. Section 238-1 of the Code of Dobbs Ferry is hereby revised as follows (all new matter <u>underlined</u>):

§ 238-1 License required; issuance and fee.

- A. No person shall peddle, vend or offer for sale in or upon any public street, sidewalk or area or from house to house in the Village any goods, wares, merchandise or other things or commodities of any description, except meat and farm products offered for sale by the producer thereof, without a license as hereinafter provided, except that such license shall not be required of an honorably discharged member of the Armed Forces of the United States who is crippled as a result of injuries received while in said armed forces and the holder of a license granted pursuant to § 32 of the General Business Law of the State of New York.
 - (1) Special sidewalk sales. Anything in this article to the contrary notwithstanding, upon request, the Village Board of Trustees may permit the selling and display for sale of merchandise on, over or upon the sidewalk at any location within the Village for a period not to exceed seven days in conjunction with a sponsored or organized sidewalk sales event open to participation by all retail merchants within the Village. Individual vendors or participants in such organized event shall be exempt from obtaining separate permits or licenses which obligation shall be the sole responsibility of the event sponsor or organizer.

Section 3. Except as otherwise provided herein, all other provisions of the Dobbs Ferry Code Chapter 238 shall remain the same.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately and shall be filed with the Secretary of State.
