PARKING PERMIT RECOMMENDATIONS

RECOMMENDATION - 9 permits TOTAL (down from 13 different types of permits)

1,2,3. Rename Central Business District Permit to "Merchant" permit and only sell it to Merchants/employees

Cost:

\$150/year for Oak Street Lot

\$150/year for Village Hall Lot

\$150/year for Cedar Street lot for first Merchant permit, then \$100/year for additional permits

for up to 6 employees.

Merchant permit holders are not subject to time limits in the respective lots.

4, 5,6. Create new permits for each parking lot

Residents only

Cost:

Cedar Street Lot -- \$125/year

Oak Street Lot-- \$150/year

Village Hall Lot -- \$150/year

Resident Parking Lot permit holders are not subject to time limits in the respective lots.

7. Residential Parking Permits

Residents only, eligibility and parking locations as directed by the Home Rule

Cost: \$25/year, limit 2 per household

WATERFRONT PARKING -- Payment for parking at the Waterfront Lot is required Monday - Sunday, 5am - 2am

8. Waterfront Commuter Parking Permit

Allows permit holders to park Monday through Sunday, 5am – 2am

Cost: \$500/year for Residents / \$1400/year Non-Residents

Without commuter permit, parkers can pay \$1/hourly via Parkmobile.

Paper daily permits are still available for sale at the front desk at Village Hall

\$10/day Residents, \$8/day Senior Citizen Residents

9. Recreation Parking Permit

Residents only.

Allows permit holders to park in designated Recreation spaces:

Monday through Friday, 5am – 5pm with a two hour time limit

(after 5pm no time limits, not restricted to Recreation spaces)

Saturday/Sunday, all day (no time limits)

Cost: \$10/year Residents, \$8/year Senior Citizen Residents
