Re: Pride Month Plans


As we are approaching Pride Month, we wanted to bring some ideas to the Board to discuss plans for June. As you know, last year we painted the LGBTQ+ flag at the intersection of Main Street and Cedar Street. We think that this method was beautiful when it was first painted but now it looks terrible due to the normal traffic that traverses over the flag every day. We also had a pretty light winter so far this year so the flag was not subject to the scraping of the plows against the pavement. We are hoping to bring to you some ideas that we feel would be a better solution to support a great cause.

OPTION 1: We would like to do in addition to whatever option is chosen, is to purchase LGBTQ+ flags to be placed along Main Street, Cedar Street and Ashford Avenue. We would like to alternate between American flags and LGBTQ+ flags.

OPTION 2: Paint a mural somewhere in the Village. There is large blank wall along Station Plaza which we would like to repair and paint a mural along the wall. This wall is visible from the Metro North platform. See location below:



OPTION 3: Paint the LGBTQ+ flag at the plaza at the corner of Main and Cedar Street on the wall behind the checker boards. See location below:



OPTION 4: Purchase something like what the Village of Tarrytown has to display banners/signs and flags. See below: We can put this on the Livingston and Broadway Island and/or mount it to the wall at the plaza at Main and Cedar Street.
