Rules and Guidelines

- No alcohol or smoking allowed in the park.
- No littering. Please recycle.
- · Dogs allowed on leash only. Please clean up after your pet.
- · Please do not feed the geese or other wildlife.
- Fishing allowed in designated areas only. Must have valid fishing permits.
- · No swimming.
- No bikes, rollerblading, skating or scooters allowed unless part of a scheduled recreation department program.
- No foul language. No loud music. Noise ordinance enforced.
- · No golfing.
- Groups of 12 or more must obtain a group park permit in order to gather.
- Use of the Great Lawn (North Field) for organized practices/games requires a permit.
- Barbeques permitted using the permanent BBQ grills only (when available). Dump hot ashes in the park's hot coal bins only.
- Open fires, ground fires, portable grills and propane use are prohibited.
- No tents or structures of any kind allowed without a permit.
- Only licensed park concessionaires permitted in park.
- Launching of non-motorized boats is permitted in the park at designated areas only.
- Individuals who violate rules will be removed from the park. Individuals
 who damage property will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
