

Update on Fight to BAN THE BARGES



We've sent a lot of information on the campaign to Ban the Barges

from anchoring in the Hudson River.

Dobbs Ferry is strongly opposed to the Coast Guard Anchorage Extension Proposal which would allow large barges to anchor off the shores of the Hudson River, including Dobbs Ferry.

Here is the latest update:

The Coast Guard has confirmed that the public comment period on the advance notice of proposed rule making regarding Hudson River anchorages <u>has been</u> <u>extended 90 days, to December 6, 2016.</u>
