

## **Ice Rink Rules**

Green Flag – Good to skate Red Flag – No Skate

Please be considerate of others at all times. These rules will be enforced to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for all:

- **BYOS: Bring Your Own Skates**
- Children under the age of 12 should be accompanied by an adult
- We recommend all those under the age of 18 wear a helmet
- No camel spins, reckless skating or speed skating
- Do not play tag
- Chain skating is not permitted (3 or more)
- Pregnant women should consult with their physician as it is not recommended to skate while pregnant
- No carrying of people or articles on ice rink
- No pets on the ice
- \* No use of hockey sticks, pucks or balls without authorization
- Do not skate against the flow of traffic skate in a counter clockwise direction

## Our rink is for skating only:

- No one is permitted on the ice without skates except staff
- No one is allowed is allowed to use the ice rink under the influence of alcohol or drug
- No food, beverage or breakable objects are allowed on the ice rink
- No chewing, smoking or tobacco products allowed on the rink or in rink area
- No profanity in the rink area
- Report all incidences or accidents to a skate guard immediately or if a skate guard is not on duty and it is an emergency call 911.
- \* We reserve the right to interrupt skating sessions for ice inspections
- We reserve the right to discontinue your session due to reckless behavior
