















Winter 2020 - Afterschool Program

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Advanced Studio Art: Grades 3-5

Instructor: Wendy Guagenti

This art class is for students who enjoy art and are looking for a more advanced, in-depth art experience.

Chess: Grades 1-5

Instructor: National Scholastic Chess Foundation, Inc.

For beginners or experienced players. Each week, students will be divided into small groups based on age and ability for structured lessons on chess strategy and supervised play. Students will learn how to analyze a chess game and learn from their own mistakes. Students will develop long-term strategies and visualization skills and begin to make connections between the skills learned through chess and other subject areas.

Comic Book Illustration: Grades 3-5

Instructor: The Digital Arts Experience

Create your own short comics using Photoshop! Students will start by using their imagination to design their own characters. They will then create short stories with their characters and bring their stories to life! Using Photoshop, students will lay out their stories in a comic book format. The class will utilize traditional drawing & digital drawing with tablets to create their comics. Students can expect to complete this class with a printed copy of their comics!

Global Culture & Crafts: Grades K-2

Instructor: BLENDID

In this class, students will be prepared to become global citizens through early exposure to the diverse cultures around them. They will learn about fascinating cultures, customs, and traditions through storytelling and hands on crafts. Students will use paper, plaster of paris, spoons, playdough, plastic wraps, feathers, and other decorative materials to make their own culturally themed souvenirs to take home.

I Made It Myself: Grades K-2

This class explores the fun and exploration of handmade crafts and art objects. Students will enjoy experimenting in mediums of clay, wood, paper and more.
