



# CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) INFO

## Village of Dobbs Ferry

### PREVENT

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Cough or sneeze into your sleeve or a tissue (not your hands), then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Put distance between yourself and other people- at least 6ft. Avoid crowded places such as theaters, restaurants and bars, fitness centers, places of worship, events and conferences, as much as possible.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a cleaning product that contains bleach.

### PREPARE

- **Make a plan:** Think about contingencies for family, home and work. Who can you contact if you need assistance?
- **Prepare as if for a winter storm:** No need to stockpile mass quantities, but have extra non-perishable foods on hand, along with soap, tissues and fever-reducing medications.
- **Get ready for possible changes in daily schedules:** Make arrangements for childcare when schools are closed. Is it possible to work from home?
- **Stay informed:** Identify reliable sources of information and updates, learn best practices for prevention and sources of support if you need it.

### TREAT

#### If you feel sick:

**Call your healthcare provider.** Do not show up without calling ahead to give them the opportunity to prevent exposure.

**Call Health Department Hotlines.** If you suspect COVID-19 and could not get answers from your medical provider, call the County or State hotlines and they will be able to direct you to resources.
