§ 300-50. Signs

B. General standards.

(3) Advertisements. No person, firm or corporation shall hang, place or cause to be placed any advertisement, placard or other notice (except legal notices), or paint or cause to be painted any advertisement or notice, on any post, pole, tree, fence or any other object in any public street, sidewalk or area in the Village, except by permission granted by the Board of Trustees. Such permission, if granted, shall be under such conditions as may be required by the Board of Trustees in each particular case.

**§ 194-3 Regulations; license fee.**

Garage sales in the Village of Dobbs Ferry shall be regulated in the following manner:

**A.**

Merchandise. Garage sales shall offer only used, unwanted items of personal property owned by the resident of the property where the sale is held. No new merchandise shall be offered for sale nor may new merchandise from other sources be brought in and offered for sale.

**B.**

Hours. Garage sales shall not commence before 10:00 a.m. and must terminate by 6:00 p.m.

**C.**

No person shall conduct more than three garage sales on his premises in any one calendar year. Such sale may not extend for a period of more than three days.<sup>(1)</sup>

**D.**

Zoning. It is not the intention of this chapter to change or amend the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Dobbs Ferry.<sup>(2)</sup>

License. Upon application, either in person or by mail, the Village Clerk is authorized to issue a license upon payment of a fee as set from time to time by the Board of Trustees.<sup>(3)</sup>
