Declaring a Local State of Emergency in the Village of Dobbs Ferry

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization designated the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, outbreak as a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, United States Health and Human Services Secretary Alex M. Azar II declared a public health emergency for the entire United States to aid the nation's healthcare community in responding to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, both travel-related cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and Westchester County, and more are expected to continue; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2020, Governor Andrew M. Cuomo declared a Disaster Emergency in the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the COVID-19 outbreak to be a global pandemic; and


WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, County Executive George Latimer declared a State of Emergency for Westchester County; and

WHEREAS, New York State, Westchester County and the Village of Dobbs Ferry are addressing the threat that COVID-19 poses to the health

and welfare of its residents and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Vincent Rossillo, Mayor of the Village of Dobbs Ferry, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of New York, hereby find, pursuant to Section 24 of Article 2-B of the N.Y. Executive Law, that there is a disaster in the Village of Dobbs Ferry that has imperiled the public safety, and I do hereby declare a local state of emergency in the Village of Dobbs Ferry as of 12 PM March 17, 2020. This Declaration shall be in effect for 30 days.
